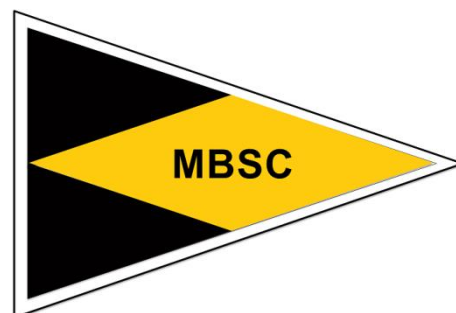

The Organising Authority is the Murrays Bay Sailing Club.

NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1. For other than the Optimist Green Fleet the regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2. For the Optimist Green Fleet the regatta will be governed by the "New Zealand International Optimist Dinghy Association Green Fleet Rules for Racing version 2010-01 – May 2010" available from <https://sites.google.com/site/nzcentreboardstandardsis/>.
- 1.3. The Laser class rules Rule 7 (a) is deleted and replaced by:
The Laser shall be raced by one person onboard. The crew shall not change during the event.
- 1.4. The YNZ Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply. Notwithstanding the dispensation granted by Yachting New Zealand, sailboard competitors shall comply with clause 1.
- 1.5. RRS Appendix P, *Special Procedures for Rule 42*, will apply as amended by the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.6. RRS Appendix T, *Arbitration*, will apply.
- 1.7. The Organising Authority may require all participating boats to display the event sponsor's advertising in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20, *Advertising Code*.

2. FORMAT

- 2.1. This championship is a one day regatta for junior, youth and senior classes including Optimist Green, Optimist Open, Open Bic, P Class, Starling Green, Starling, Laser 4.7, Laser Radial, RS Feva, 420, 29er, Kona, RSX 8.5 and Techno board, Laser, 470, Nacra, RSX 9.5, Raceboards, Hobie 16, 3.7, 49er, Zephyr, Javelin, Paper Tiger, Jolly Boat, Sunburst, etc.
- 2.2. A minimum of 4 boats per class is required for a separate fleet to be sailed.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. The regatta is open to all centreboard boats and sailboards complying with their class rules provided 4 or more of any class enters by the closing time of 0900hrs Saturday 16th September.

- 3.2. Entries will be made by going to [Murrays Bay NOR Page](#) and completing the Icebreaker entry form published with the Notice of Race. Please email to info@murraysbay.org
Pay your entry fee to our bank account, 12 3042 0272614 02, or pay cash on the day.
- 3.3. Entry Fees are :
Single Handed Classes \$25.00
Double Handed Classes \$30.00
- 3.4. Measurement is not required, but classes for which measurement certificates are a class rule, may be required to submit proof of holding a valid measurement or rating certificate.
- 3.5. To be eligible to compete in this event each competitor shall be a member of a club or other organisation affiliated to the National Authority.
- 3.6. Entries will not be accepted from, or may be cancelled for, any boat not displaying its correct sail number or displaying the same sail number as any other boat in the same race.

4. ENTRY CLOSING DATE

- 4.1. Entries will be accepted up to 0900 on Saturday 16th September.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 5.1. The New Zealand Centreboard Standard Sailing Instruction effective from 1st January 2017 (Centreboard Clubs Standard Sailing Instructions 2017 v11.pdf) will apply and are available at <https://sites.google.com/site/nzcentreboardstandardsis/>
- 5.2. The Regatta Specific Schedule will be available at MBSC on race day.

6. VENUE

- 6.1. The regatta will be based at Murrays Bay Sailing Club.
- 6.2. Racing will take place on the waters off Murrays Bay Beach.

7. MEASUREMENT

- 7.1. All boats must comply with their class rules at all times during the regatta.
- 7.2. Wet clothing, measurement and equipment checks may be made throughout the Regatta at the discretion of the Race Committee or Protest Committee.

8. PROGRAMME

- 8.1. Registration will be from 0800Hrs on Saturday 16th September
- 8.2. Racing Schedule:
Briefing 0915hrs
Race 1 1000hrs (Time of first warning signal)
Race 2 Back to Back
Race 3 Back to Back
Race 4 Back to back
Prize giving As soon as possible after Race 4.

9. ALTERNATIVE PENALTIES

- 9.1. For the 49er, 29er, Javelin, other skiff and catamaran classes rule 44.1, *Taking a Penalty*, is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by a One-Turn Penalty.

10. SCORING

- 10.1. The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A, *Scoring*, will apply.
- 10.2. One race is required to be completed to constitute a championship.

11. SAFETY

- 11.1. Competitors shall wear a life jacket or other adequate personal buoyancy at all times when afloat.
- 11.2. Wet suits and dry suits do not constitute adequate personal buoyancy.

12. LAUNCHING RESTRICTIONS

- 12.1. All boats, will be required to launch and retrieve from Murrays Bay beach except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.
